Asparagus Seed Planting - Growing Instructions:

Step: 1 Receiving Your Asparagus Seeds

- a. Leave the asparagus seeds in the plastic bag. Look to see if there is any moisture. There should not be any moisture in the bag.

Materials: 2 Freezer bags. Get 2 thick freezers plastic bags put one inside the other. 1 Glass Jar

- b. Now put the plastic bag with the asparagus seeds inside the two freezer bags. So its double bagged.
- c. Gently press the air out of the bags and seal (close) it.
- d. Stuff all of this into a glass jar and put it into your refrigerator.

Notes: Don't let any moisture get into the bag / jar.



Asparagus Seed Planting Instructions:

Step: 2 Prepare The Soil Then Plant The Asparagus Seeds

- a. Decide where you will keep your potted asparagus seeds . The place that you choose to keep your potted asparagus seeds should be a sunny location and that is draft free.

Materials: Gather the following items: Clay, glass, peat, pots, Clean Pail/Bag, Potting Soil, Water

b. Pots:

Using big or small pots makes no difference. If you use 6 inch pots then the asparagus plants will not have to be transplanted again. The plants can go from the 6 inch pots to the garden when the asparagus plants reach 4 inches tall.

- c. Get a clean pail or paper bag. Use this to mix your soil in.
- d. Get some soil from your yard mix insome compost.
- e. If you know for sure that your soil is acid then throw 1 1/2 hands full of lime into the pail. Mix it all together.
- f. If the soil is dry add a little water or [asparagus garaden tea](#). The goal is to have moist soil.

Notes: Now put all this stuff aside. Asparagus Seeds in small pots tend to get over watered so be careful.

Asparagus Seed Planting Instructions

Step: 3 Soak and Disinfect the Seeds . . . Easy as 1, 2, 3

- a. Now we are going to soak the asparagus seeds for 15 minutes to disinfect them.This will get rid any problems (such as fungus that my have developed).

Materials: Bowl (soup bowl size and some water.

- b. Take two strong paper towels and lay them one on top of the other at the bottom of a salad or soup bowl.
- c. Just soak the seeds.
- d. Add 1 1 / 2cups of water. (a regular size coffee cup works well).
- e. Gently stir the water and the powder until it is all dissolved
- f. Now add the seeds.The asparagus seeds should end up in the towel.
- g. Soak the asparagus seeds for 15 mintues longer.



Asparagus Seeds Planting Instructions

Step: 4 Rise . . . Rise . . . Rise . . . The Asparagus Seeds

- a. Lift the paper towels with the seeds out of the bowl and water.
- b. Fold up the paper towel a little so the seeds dont fall out .
- c. Keep the seeds folded up in the paper towels. Now rinse the seeds gentlyly in tap water .
- d. While rinsing gently squeeze the paper towel to remove the disinfectant.

Notes: After soaking and rising the seeds we are going to soak the seeds 2nd time.This time in tap water.

Asparagus Seed Planting Instructions

Step: 5 Soak the Asparagus Seeds For 24 Hours

- a. Grab a Clean bowl
- b. Put Paper towels in the bottom. Fill 1/2 full of tap water.
- c. Soak for 24 hours. At room temperature.

Materials: Water, paper towels, clean bowl, clock

Notes: Asparagus seeds have a very tuff seed coat. The soaking softens the asparagus seeds coat and starts the germination process.

Asparagus Seed Planting Instructions

Step: 6 Easy Simple Fast Planting the Asparagus Seeds

- a. While the asparagus seeds soak for 24 hrs be sure and have your pots and soil ready.
- b. Fertile, humus, garden soil is ok just add some lime and compost
- c. Plant 3 seed in a pot :very small pot: 2 inch pot
Plant 5 seeds in a medium size pot: 3 inch pot
Plant 3 seeds large pot: 6 inch pot
- d. Leave 1/2 inch to 1 inch between seeds.
- e. Put pots in a place where it will only get 50% shade.
- f. Temp 78 - 80 degrees. Don't let the soil dry out and dont over water

Yahooooo!!

If all goes well the seeds will germinate in about 3 - 4 weeks.

- g. Thin plants out at 2 - 3 inches tall. 1 plant per pot . Replant thinned-out ones .
Plant outside at 4 - 5 inches at 68 - 70 degrees.
